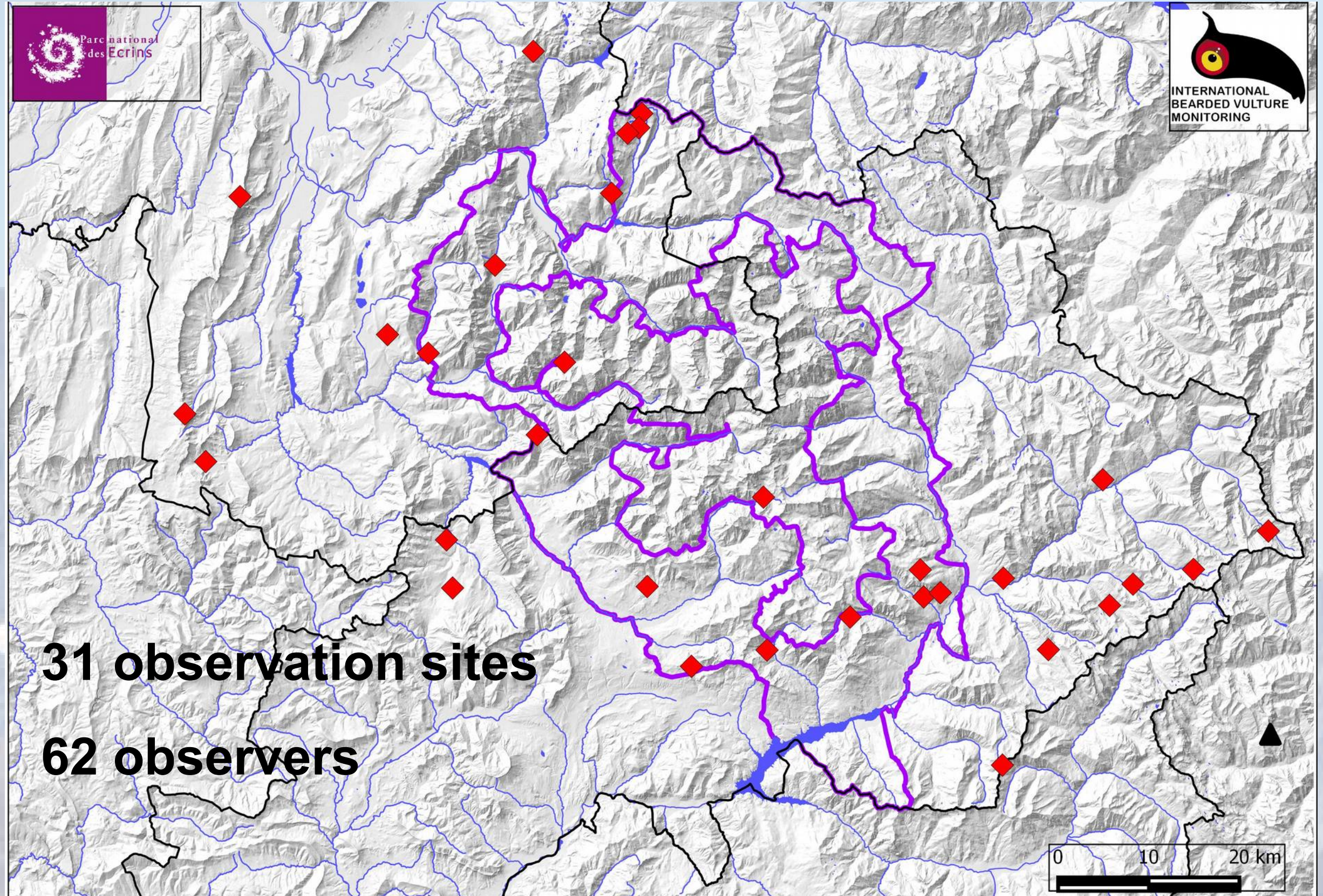

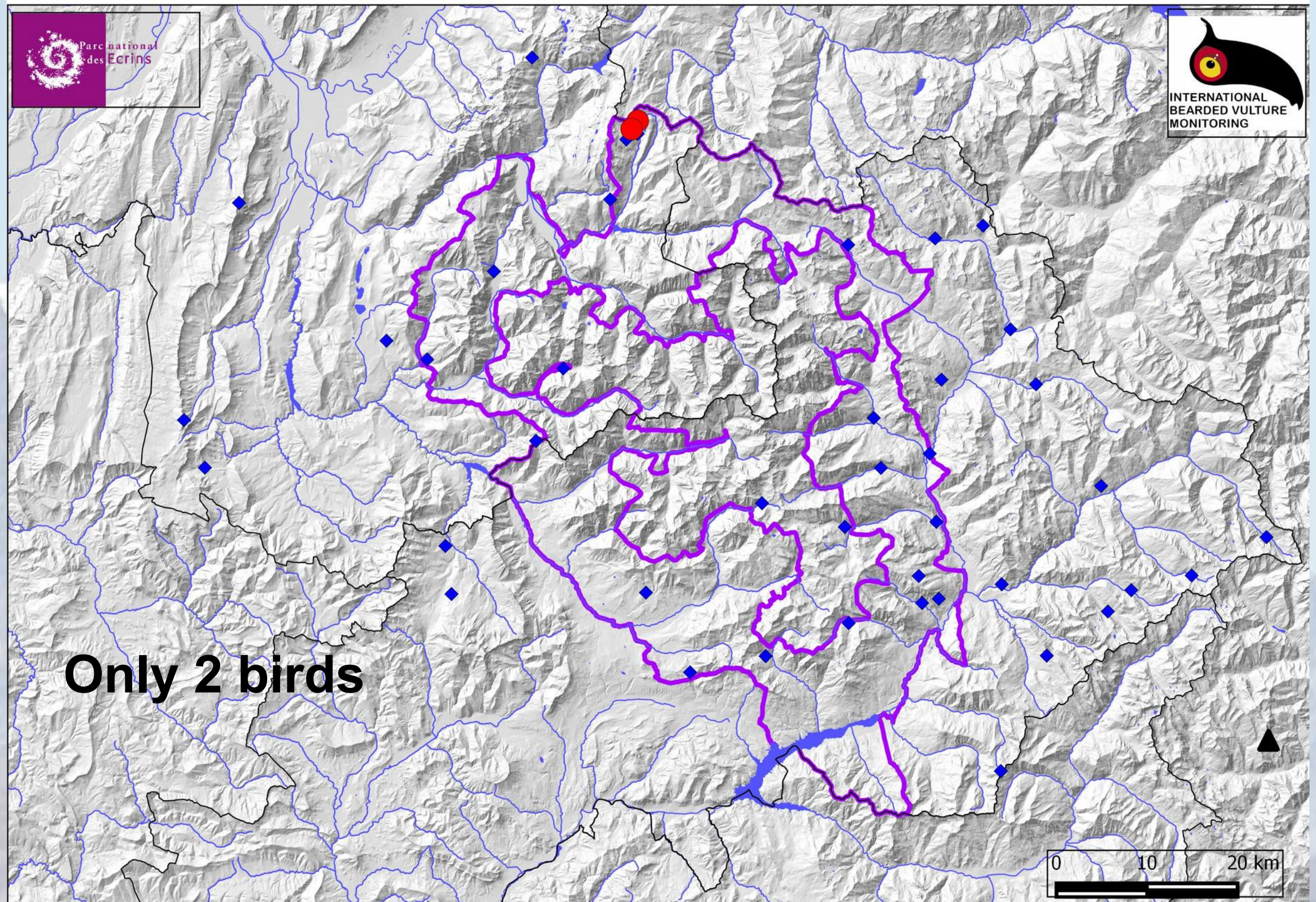

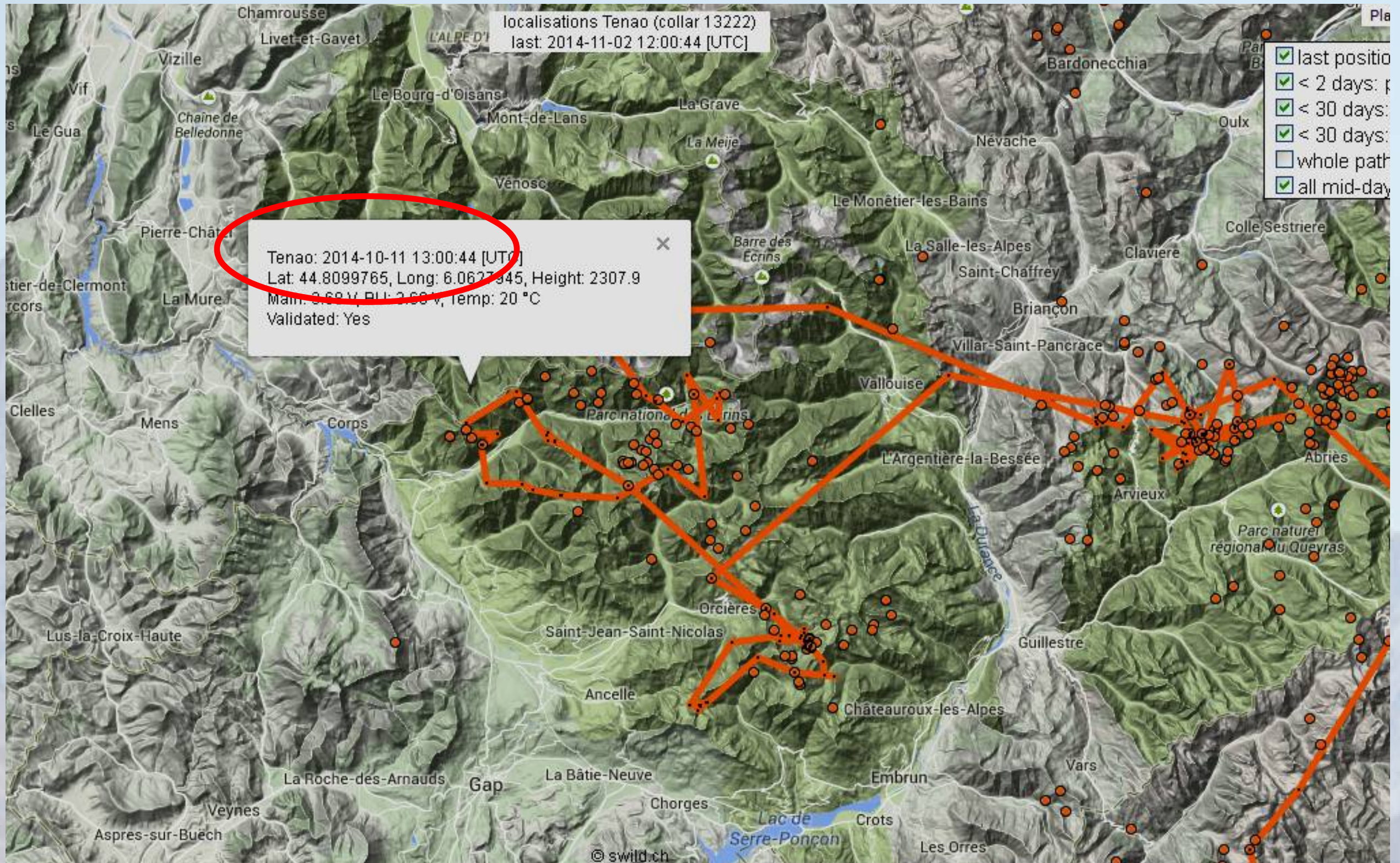

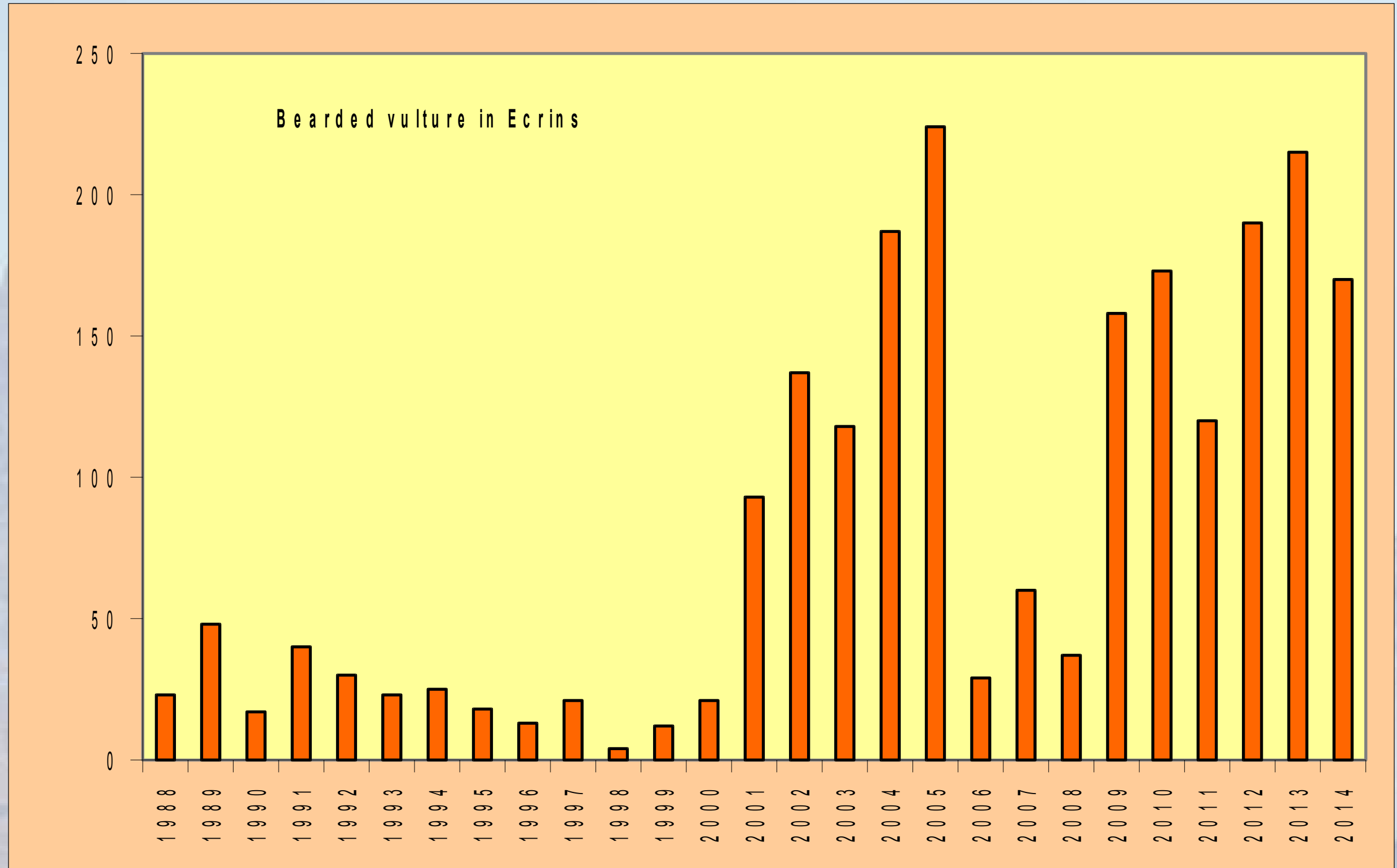

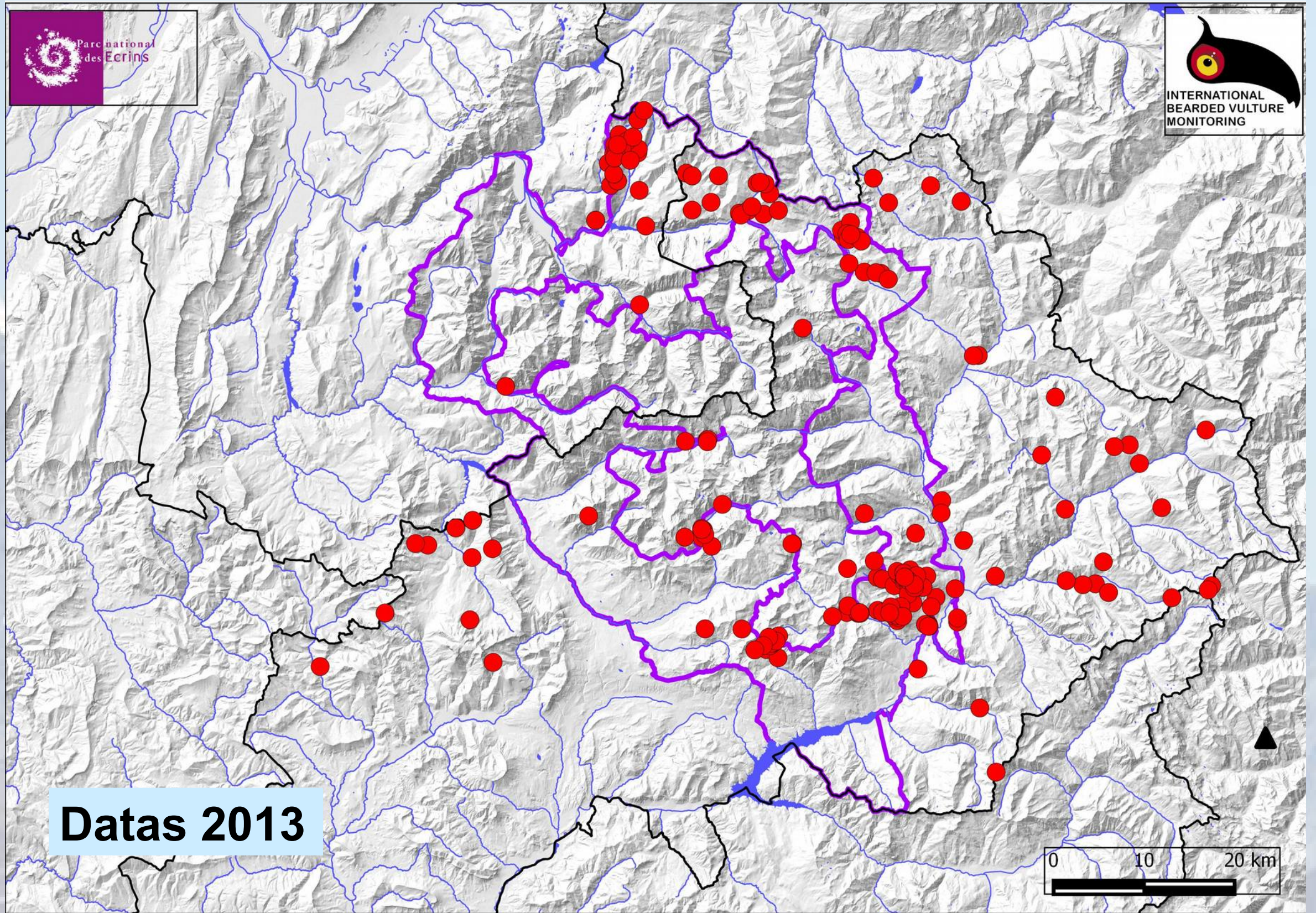

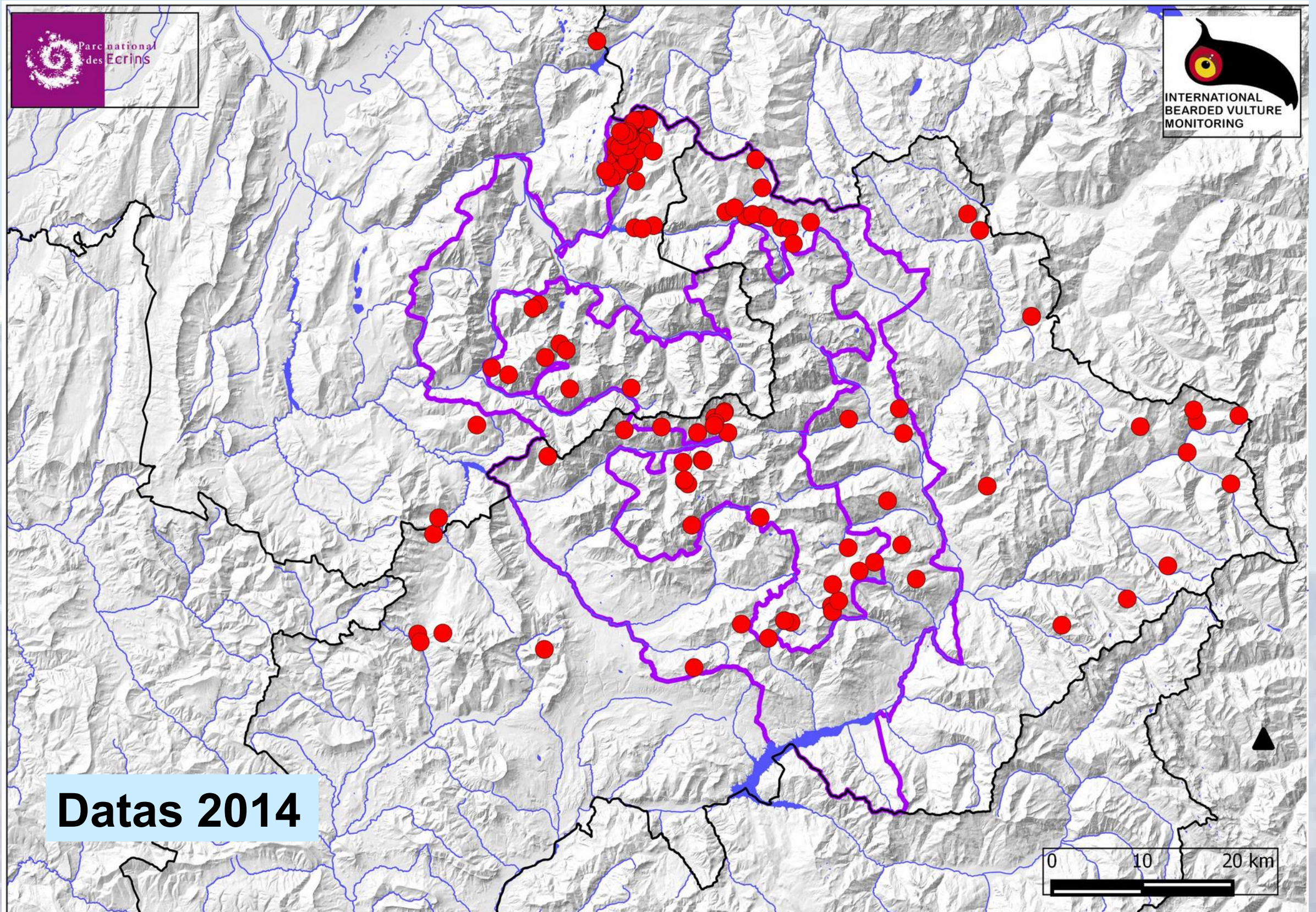

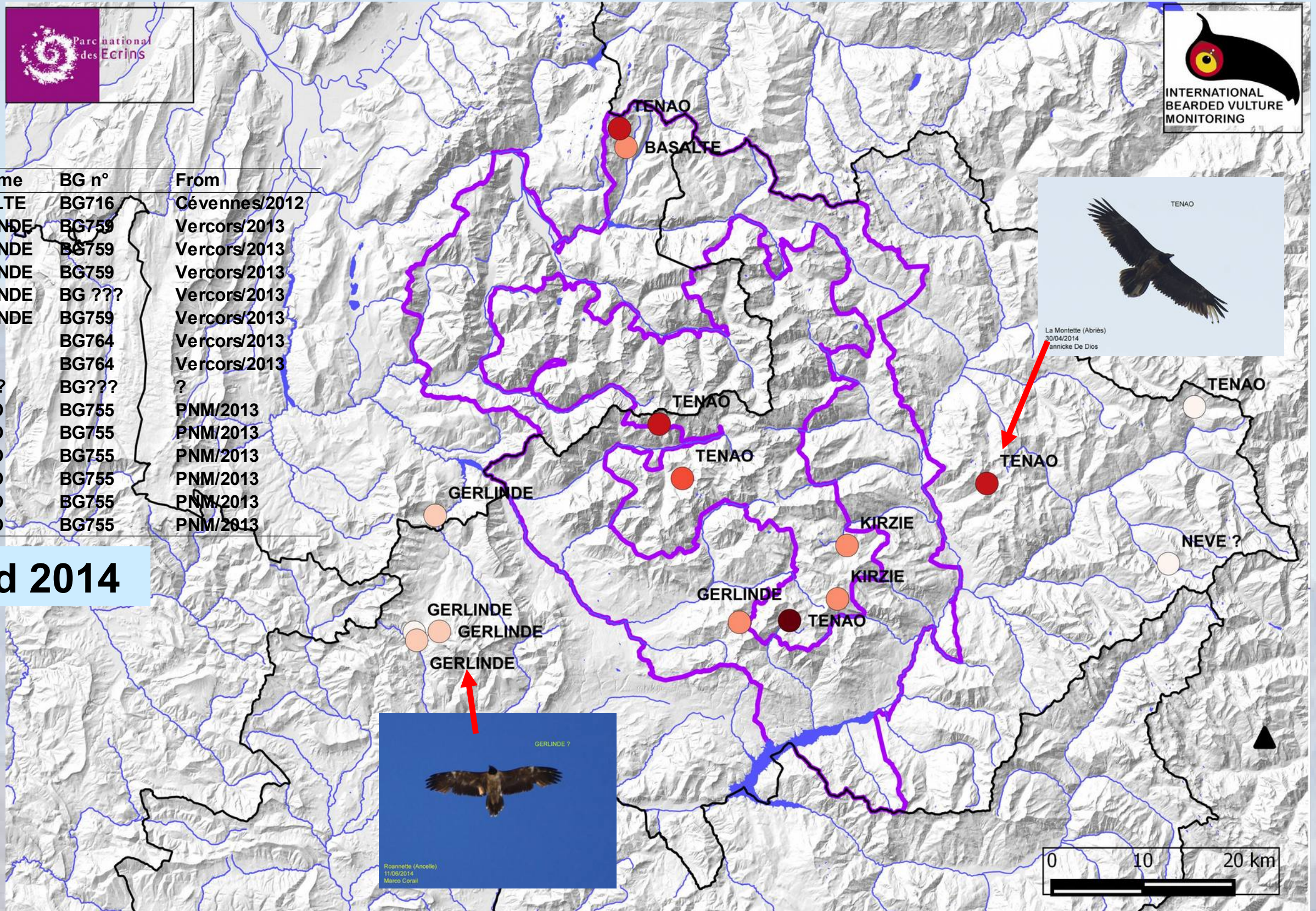

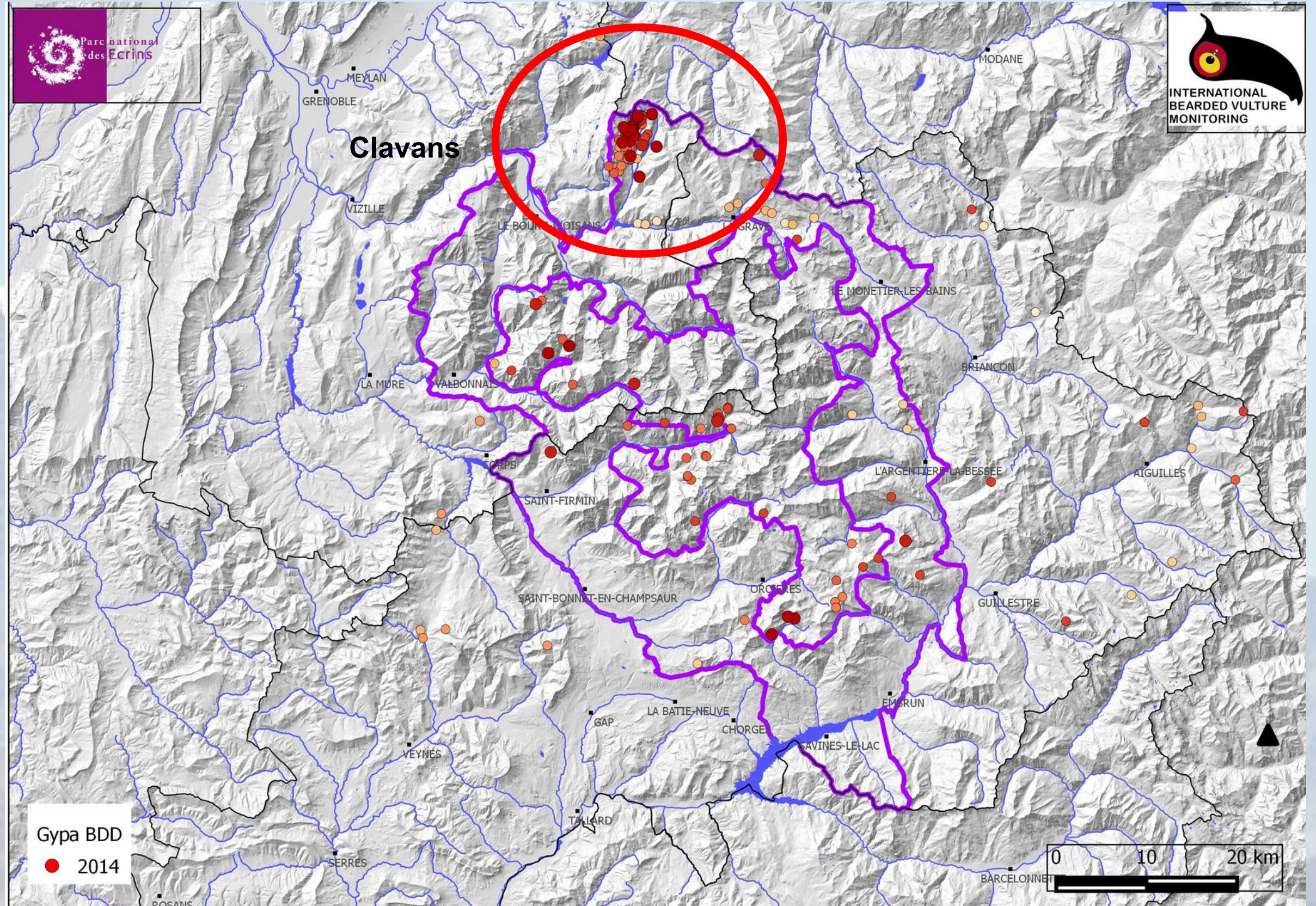

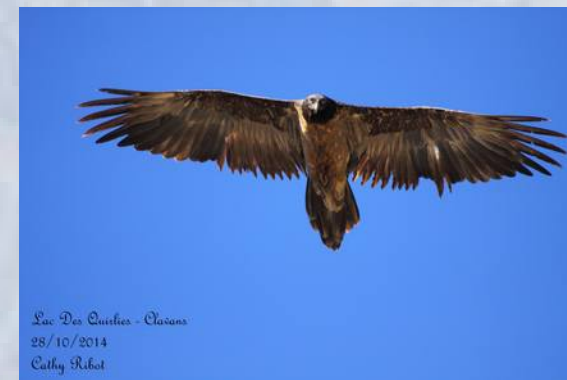


One wolf (or more) was suspected on this area. More than 40 observations on herd attack was made on nearly 200 sheep killed.
